The 38th Annual Western Regional Conference on Behavior Analysis is scheduled to occur March 6-8th at the Santa Clara Convention Center. CalABA has been in constant contact with our conference team and Board of Directors over the last few days regarding coronavirus.

The Santa Clara County Department of Health believes “immediate risk to the public remains low” but is also advising preparation for potential widespread transmission*. Given the rapidly changing circumstances regarding coronavirus, CalABA is suspending our current cancellation policy for the conference and will allow any attendee who does not want to attend our conference a full refund.
